## What we require from you:

- Fluency in English and one or more of the above languages
- Some interpretation experience (preferred), whether in the community or professionally
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Cultural awareness and a commitment to professional boundaries
- Understanding of confidentiality and safeguarding protocols
- Emotional resilience and ability to act impartially at all times
